YOUNG PEOPLE'S CHORUS OF NEW YORK CITY

Young People's Chorus of New York City (YPC) is a multicultural youth chorus internationally renowned for its superb virtuosity, brilliant showmanship, and innovative model of diversity. Founded by Artistic Director Francisco J. Núñez, a MacArthur Fellow and Musical America's 2018 Educator of the Year, YPC's spectacular artistry has been showcased in award-winning performances around the world.

With repertoire that spans Renaissance and classical traditions through gospel, folk, jazz, pop, contemporary and world music, YPC also continually invigorates its catalogue of music for young voices by commissioning pieces of diverse music from many of the most distinguished and emerging composers of our time. The chorus frequently inspires invitations from a wide range of cultural institutions and festivals, and recently performed in front of a national televised audience during the 9/11 20th Anniversary Memorial, at the renowned Global Citizen Live festival this fall, at the Saks Fifth Avenue Holiday Light Show alongside guest speaker Michelle Obama and at the 95th annual Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade.

Among YPC's many awards is America's highest honor for youth programs, a National Arts and Humanities Youth Program Award, which was presented to members of YPC at the White House. Under the direction of YPC's Associate Artistic Director, Elizabeth Núñez, YPC also earned the distinction of "Choir of the World" in July 2018 at the International Choral Kathaumixw (Powell River, British Columbia), marking the first time a North American chorus has ever won this title in the 34-year history of Kathaumixw. YPC has received a Chorus America Education Outreach Award, two Chorus America/ASCAP Awards for Adventurous Programming and a 2017 Margaret Hillis Award for Choral Excellence.



MEET THE ARTISTS



Lester Lynch, who has established himself among today's most important dramatic baritones, is making his mark in many of the world's leading opera houses. Known for his charismatic portrayals and commanding voice, he receives rave reviews in opera's most important baritone roles from Scarpia and Rigoletto to Count di Luna. *Opera Today* recently enthused, "It was booming baritone Lester Lynch who served notice that he is now in consideration for admittance to the 'Scarpia Preferred Pantheon.'" Lester has recently performed Lescaut in *Manon Lescaut* under Sir Simon Rattle with the Festspielhaus Baden-Baden, Crown in *Porgy and Bess* with Opéra de Montréal, Amonasro in Verdi's *Aida* with Pittsburgh Opera, and featured roles with San Francisco Opera, Lyric Opera of Chicago, the Bregenz Festival, and Minnesota Opera. He recently sang back-to-back performances as Iago in Verdi's *Otello* and the title role in Verdi's *Falstaff* in his debut with Portugal's Fundação Calouste Gulbenkian. Upcoming performances include Welsh National Opera, Bergen National Opera in Norway, and the Warsaw National Opera. Future recordings include Iago in Verdi's *Otello*, Porgy in Gershwin's *Porgy and Bess* and a Verissimo French Aria CD to be recorded by Pentatone Classics.



Lynn Ahrens is a lyricist and librettist with an extensive career in theater, film and television. With longtime collaborator Stephen Flaherty, she won Tony, Drama Desk and Outer Critics Circle Awards for the Broadway musical *Ragtime* and was nominated for two Academy Awards and two Golden Globes for Twentieth Century Fox's animated feature film, *Anastasia*, which they also adapted for Broadway. Additional Broadway: *Once On This Island*, (Tony Award, Best Revival); *Seussical* (one of the most produced shows in America); Madison Square Garden's *A Christmas Carol* (composer Alan Menken); *My Favorite Year*; *Rocky*; *Chita Rivera: The Dancer's Life*. Off Broadway: *Lucky Stiff*; *A Man of No Importance*; *Dessa Rose*; *The Glorious Ones*; Upcoming: *Knoxville*; *Little Dancer*. Film: Lyrics for *Anastasia*, *Camp*, *After the Storm*, *Lucky Stiff*, *Nasrin*. Ahrens has been nominated for four Grammys and won the Emmy for her work in network television. She's a mainstay singer/songwriter for the classic animated series *Schoolhouse Rock*. Her short stories and essays have been published nationally and her work has been nominated for Best American Essays and the Pushcart Anthology. She serves on Council for the Dramatists Guild of America and co-founded the DGF Fellows Program for Emerging Writers with Stephen Flaherty. In 2014 Ahrens and Flaherty received the Oscar Hammerstein Award for Lifetime Achievement and in 2015 they were inducted into the Theater Hall of Fame. www.ahrensandflaherty.com.



Francisco J. Núñez, a MacArthur Fellow and Musical America's 2018 Educator of the Year, is a composer, conductor, visionary, leading figure in music education, and the artistic director/founder of the Young People's Chorus of New York City (YPC). Since he established the chorus in 1988, he has created an awareness of the ability of young people to rise to unforeseen heights of artistry and recognition among composers of the child's voice as a significant instrument for making music. The *New York Times* has praised him for "raising the bar [for children's choruses] by commissioning a steady stream of works from composers who usually write for adults."

Mr. Núñez also leads the University Glee Club of New York City, its fifth conductor since the all-men's chorus was established in 1894 and is sought after as a guest conductor and

master teacher by orchestras and choirs nationwide; a collaborator with arts organizations worldwide; and is currently curating an installation with High Line Nine of live performances, video, art, and film, highlighted by the YPC premieres of 15 works of music Mr. Núñez has commissioned from among today's most distinguished and innovative composers, presented along with poetry written and recorded by the choristers.

The many achievements of YPC have led Mr. Núñez to establish YPC National, which is now expanding the YPC model to children's choruses beyond New York City.

As a composer Mr. Núñez creates countless compositions and arrangements in all musical formats and styles for choirs, orchestras, and solo instruments. Among his many awards and honors are ASCAP's Victor Herbert Award, the New York Choral Society's Choral Excellence Award, and Bang on a Can's Visionary Award. NYU Steinhardt has presented him with its Distinguished Alumnus Achievement Award, and he holds honorary Doctor of Music degrees from both Ithaca College and Gettysburg College.



Elizabeth Núñez, Associate Artistic Director of the Young People's Chorus of New York City, directs children from 8 to 18 in rehearsals, performances, and tours throughout the U.S. and abroad. She also oversees YPC's School Choruses program, which brings YPC's unique music curriculum into 20 New York City schools. Elizabeth has conducted YPC singers in the city's most prestigious venues—from Carnegie Hall to the Apollo Theater—as well as on national television. She has prepared YPC for their debuts in both Lincoln Center's

Mostly Mozart and White Light Festivals; for their world premiere performances in Julia Wolfe's acclaimed multimedia work *Fire in My Mouth* with the New York Philharmonic; and led YPC to the title of "Choir of the World" in competition. Beyond music, Elizabeth created WIT: Women Inspiring Tomorrow, a mentoring program that connects YPC's high school girls to accomplished women across varying professions. She is also the Founding Artistic Director of SoHarmoniums, an intergenerational women's community chorus, based in New York City's SoHo neighborhood. Elizabeth is also sought after as a choral clinician and is the recipient of Lee University School of Music's Distinguished Alumnus Award for her commitment to "changing the lives of America's youth."



Sophia Papoulis, Associate Conductor of the Young People's Chorus of New York City, is the principal conductor of the Prelude division and oversees YPC's Education program, supporting YPC choristers beyond the music academically, socially, and professionally. Since 2007, she has conducted and prepared young people ages 8 to 18 in all YPC divisions for performances in New York City's most prestigious venues from Carnegie Hall to Lincoln Center, as well as throughout North and South America, Asia, and Europe. She prepares

and conducts YPC choruses for radio and television appearances, recording sessions, and collaborative performances with such artists as Meredith Monk and the Kronos Quartet. Sophia is also the Associate Director of YPC National, supporting and inspiring youth choruses and choral conductors nationwide. She is sought-after and invited by choral organizations around the country to appear as a guest conductor, presenting choral workshops and conducting All-State Honor Choirs. Sophia is a magna cum laude graduate of the Ithaca College School of Music.



Maria C. Peña is currently an Assistant Conductor at YPC. Inspired by YPC's work with children and the community, Maria joined the organization in 2012 and enjoys helping young choristers grow and find their own voices. She co-conducts the Intermezzo division and oversees YPC's community choruses in Washington Heights and Goddard Riverside. Additionally, she is a conductor for the School Choruses program, bringing YPC's music curriculum into New York City schools. In 2019, Maria was awarded the PASEsetter Award for

her commitment to children's afterschool education. Originally from Colombia, Maria came to YPC after conducting with the Jacksonville Children's Chorus and a retirement community chorus in Jacksonville, Florida. She has been invited to conduct overseas in the Canary Islands, Spain. Maria holds a Bachelor of Music, summa cum laude, in voice performance from the University of North Florida (UNF). She has studied under the mentorship Dr. Cara Tasher and Dr. Doreen Rao.



Caitlin Henning, Assistant Conductor of the Young People's Chorus of New York City, conducting the Intermezzo chorus for children ages 10-15 and also manages YPC's School Choruses program. Caitlin joined YPC in 2014 and previously worked with the Young People's Chorus of Erie, where she was the director of education, assistant conductor of the training ensemble of beginning and intermediate singers, and YPC Erie's four satellite choirs. She holds a BM in music education from Ithaca College and an MA in music education at

Teachers College, Columbia University. In Ithaca, Caitlin worked with all five divisions of the Ithaca Children's Choir under the mentorship of Dr. Janet Galván, completed studies for teaching middle school boys with autism, and taught early childhood music as a teacher at the Community School of Music and Arts. She has held a variety of leadership positions in music organizations, including the Northwest chair of the Pennsylvania American Choral Directors Association.



Emma Hathaway, Assistant Conductor at the Young People's Chorus of New York City, is the principal conductor of YPC's community choruses at Goddard Riverside and Washington Heights, a conductor for the YPC Schools Choruses program and assistant conductor for YPC's Chorale division. In addition to conducting, Emma is a frequent violin accompanist for YPC. Emma joined YPC five years ago upon graduating summa cum laude from Yale University with a BA in Music and a certificate in Education Studies. Emma also holds an

MA in Music Education from the University of Hartford's The Hartt School, with Kodály and FAME certification.



Steven Kirby, Conducting Fellow at Young People's Chorus of New York City, where he is the principal conductor of YPC's Amani division, assists with the Young Men's division, and is a private voice instructor in the Matisse Fellows program. A professional opera singer, Steve is passionate about helping youth discover, cultivate, and craft their own voice. In addition to his work with YPC, Steven is a teacher of music in the voice department at Frank Sinatra High School of Performing Arts. Steven is also an assistant conductor

of the New York City All City High School Chorus and maintains his own private voice studio. In addition to his teaching and choral conducting career, Steven can be seen and

heard in numerous operas, oratorios and musicals around the United States and Europe performing baritone. He has performed in *Così fan Tutte*, *Ragtime*, *Madama Butterfly*, *Gianni Schicci*, *Porgy & Bess*, *Carmen*, *Il Trovatore*, *Show Boat*, *My Fair Lady*, *Kiss Me Kate*, *Le Nozze di Figaro*, *Pirates of Penzance*, *La Traviata*, *Pagliacci* and Handel's *Messiah*, among others. Steven earned both his B.M. in Music Education and M.M. in Voice Performance & Pedagogy degrees from Westminster Choir College.



Ahra Cho is a Conducting Fellow at Young People's Chorus of New York City. In this position, Ahra is a conductor for the YPC Schools Choruses program. She also assists with YPC's community chorus in Washington Heights. Prior to joining YPC, Ahra held the position of Director at Chicago Little OL Children's Choir in Chicago. Ahra was born in South Korea, where she was raised by two teachers who loved their work and inspired her to become an educator as well. She earned a master's degree in Voice Performance from Roosevelt University and minored in Piano. She also holds a master's degree in Choral Conducting, where she studied under the tutelage of Dr. Karyl Carlson. Ahra is currently studying with Dr. Doreen Rao, and Hee-Churl Kim.



Taisiya Pushkar, Collaborative Pianist at Young People's Chorus of New York City. Her journey began at YPC back in 2014, playing for the choir extensively before joining the team full time in 2019. While Taisiya's main role at YPC is as a pianist, she also helps manage the larger pool of pianists as they travel between local schools and YPC's Home, and assists in coordinating instrumentalists for larger choral performances. Born in Moldova, Taisiya brought her love of music to New York City at just eleven years old when her family located

to Brooklyn. She has continued to foster her musical passions ever since, performing in collaborations with singers and instrumentalists in the US and abroad. Taisiya received her bachelor's degree in Piano Performance at Oberlin College, and went on to receive her Master's in Piano Performance and Doctorate in Collaborative Piano from the Manhattan School of Music.
